Open PHACTS provides an **“integrated platform of publicly available pharmacological and physicochemical data”**



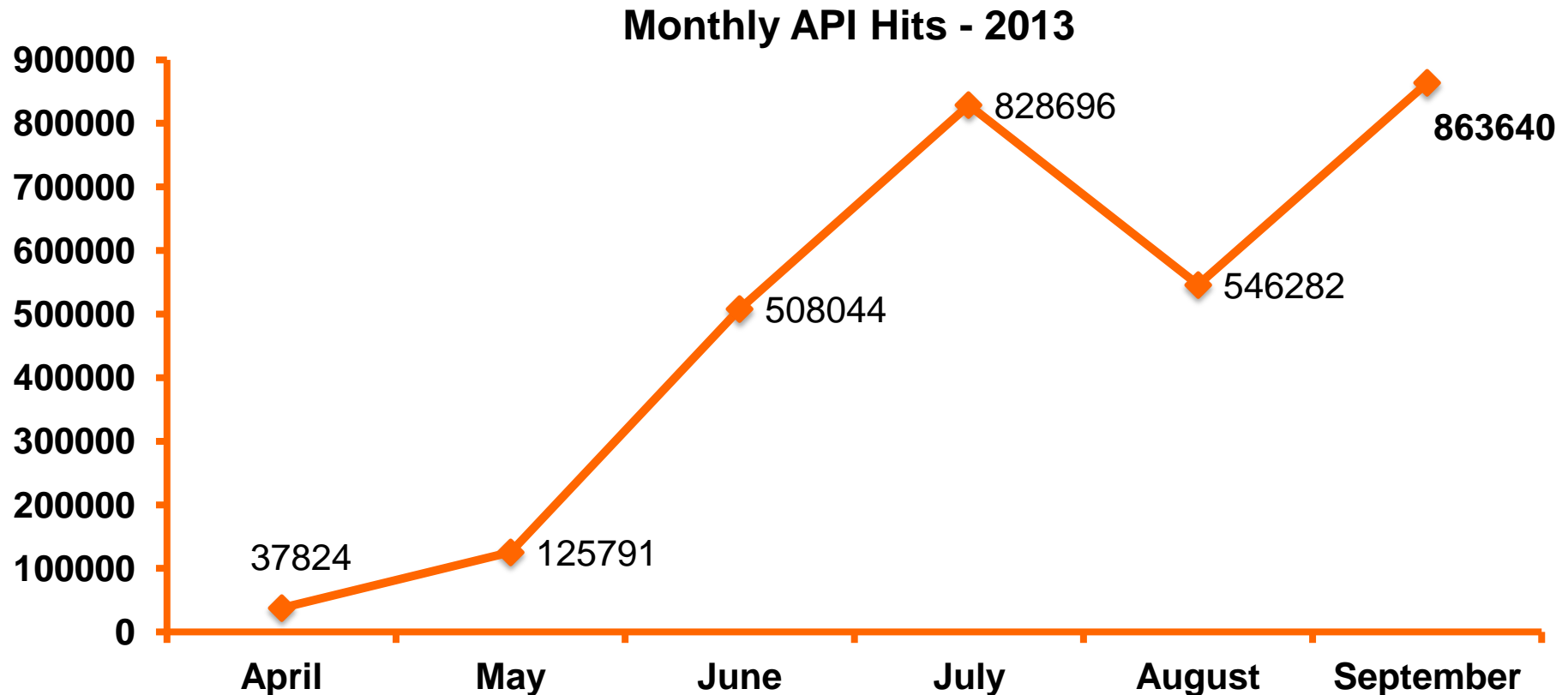
Accessible via:  **Open PHACTS Discovery Platform**

What has Open PHACTS done so far?

- Created a viable shared infrastructure for data integration - **The Open PHACTS Discovery Platform**
- Created an **API for drug discovery**
- Pragmatic framework to deliver **business-relevant solutions**
- Established itself within the wider community and facilitated idea exchange & collaboration - **A unique forum**



The Open PHACTS project is funded by the Innovative Medicines Initiative (IMI) and EFPIA companies' in kind contribution.



The project was originally to end in March 2014, now extended until August 2014
